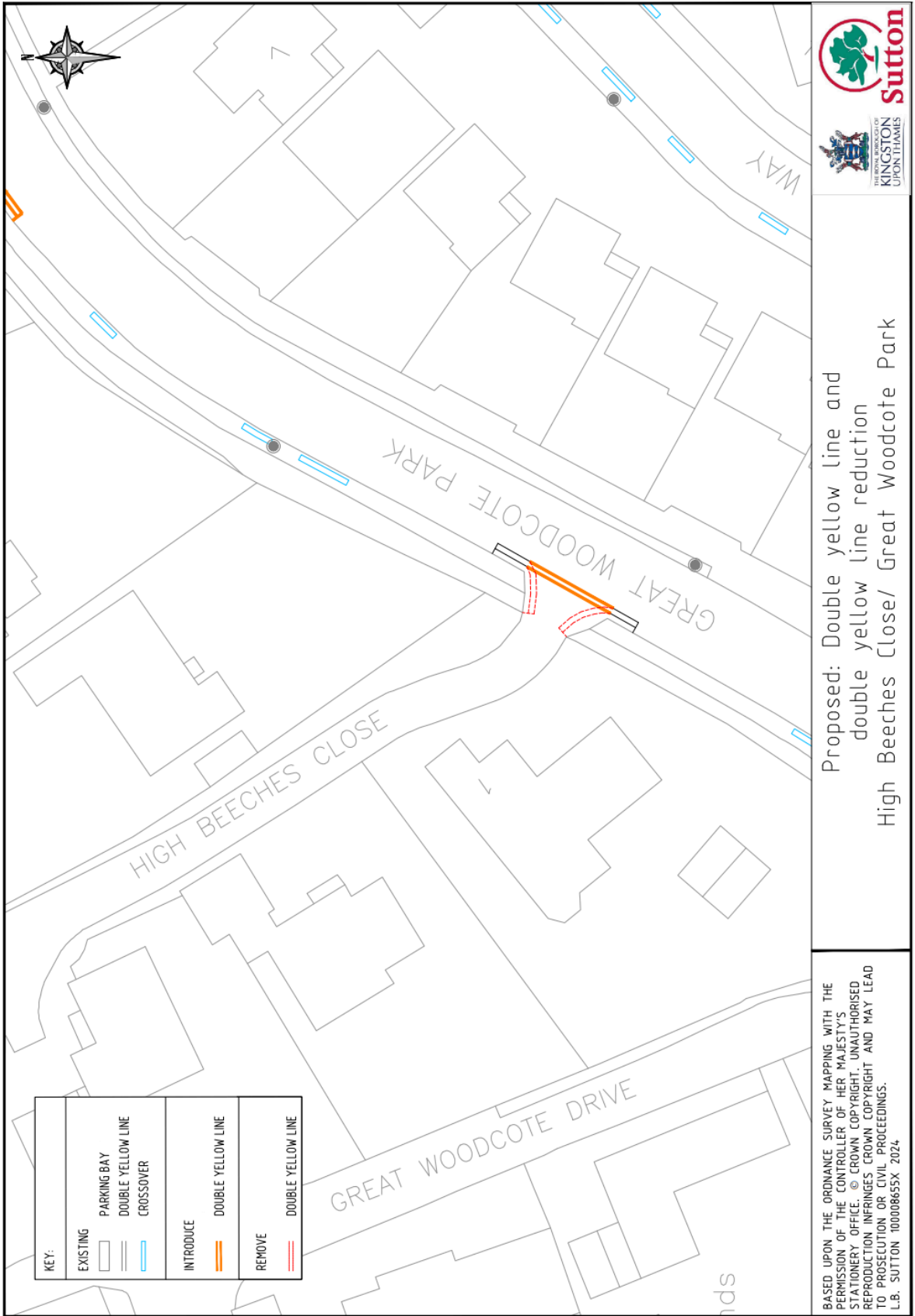
This final stage of consultation will end on **7 November 2024**.
