Proposed parking changes for Marlborough Rd

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton. Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

Proposal for Marlborough Rd

Due to access issues for local buses we are proposing a number of changes to Marlborough Rd including:

- introducing double yellow lines outside Nos 8, 14, 15 and 18-20
- removal of a short section of double yellow lines adjacent to No 61 Dibdin Rd
- removal of double yellow lines outside No 13 to include a short area next to the green space adjacent to No 41 Lymescote Gardens
- introducing partial pavement parking at various locations on Marlborough Rd.

The proposals seek to maximise available parking within existing street furniture and trees. For more detail, see a map of the proposals on the back of this letter.
