## Proposed parking changes for Woodcote Green, Woodcote Road and Sandy Lane South

Following our informal consultation in February 2024 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

#### Proposal for Woodcote Green, Woodcote Road and Sandy Lane South

Following local requests we are proposing double yellow lines around the Woodcote Green triangle due to parking obstructions, particularly at school pick up and drop off.

We are proposing two short sections of double yellow lines on Woodcote Green, one outside the garage and the other between Nos 5-8, to allow for passing places.

We are also proposing single yellow line waiting restrictions along one side of Sandy Lane South, operating Monday to Friday 8.30am-9.30am and 3pm-4pm, to reduce congestion and parking obstructions **(see detailed map on the back of this letter)**.
