Proposed parking changes for Marlborough Road

Following our informal consultation in October 2024 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

Proposal for Marlborough Road

Due to access issues for local buses we are proposing a number of changes to Marlborough Road including:

- introducing double yellow lines outside Nos 8, 14, 15 and 18-20
- removal of a short section of double yellow lines adjacent to No 61 Dibdin Road
- removal of double yellow lines outside No 13 to include a short area next to the green space adjacent to No 41 Lymescote Gardens
- introducing partial pavement parking at various locations on Marlborough Road.

The proposal seeks to maximise available parking within existing street furniture and trees. For more detail, see a map of the proposals on the back of this letter.
