THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SUTTON (ELM GROVE ESTATE) COMPULSARY PURCHASE ORDER 2024

I write on behalf of Southern Gas Networks Plc ("SGN"), the Ofgem licensed Gas Transporter for the South and South East of England.

SGN own and operate low pressure gas mains within and in the vicinity of the Order boundary, the location of which are illustrated on the enclosed Infrastructure Plan.

SGN **objects** to the Order due to concerns that it may adversely affect the integrity of and/or access to these gas mains which form an integral part of the local gas network. They are subject to very specific working practices that must be followed by any third party.

To ensure that these working practices are observed and all reasonable measures are taken prior to any works taking place, SGN will require the London Borough of Sutton to enter into a legally binding Asset Protection Agreement.


